

Changing Your Major To ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING

Students planning to enter an engineering major or to change from one engineering major to another will be expected to complete at least 30 units at UCSB before petitioning for a change of major. Students normally must satisfy the prerequisites of the prospective major. Students who have completed more than 105 units will not be considered for a change of major/change of college in engineering or computer science unless they can demonstrate that they will be able to complete all the degree requirements for the proposed program without exceeding 200 total units. Students may petition for a change of major when the requirements below have been met.

REQUIREMENTS

1. An overall UCSB grade point average of at least 3.0.
2. Satisfactory completion at UCSB, with a grade point average of 3.0 or better, of at least 5 classes, including at least two mathematics classes, from the following:
 - Math 5A-B-C**
 - ECE 2A-B-C**
 - ECE15A**

*The calculation of the minimum GPA will be based on all classes completed from this list at the time of petitioning.
